With the school year underway, we need our community's support to **ensure every child in our community has the tools and resources to succeed**. Good mental health, physical resilience, and wellness are essential for effective learning, yet many children face barriers to accessing the behavioral health services they deserve.

Together, we can break down barriers and empower young people like "Sam" and "Jane" (names changed for privacy), who have achieved the significant milestone of graduating from our non-public schools (NPS) in <u>San Diego</u> and <u>Oakland</u>. Both schools are state-of-the-art non-public schools, certified by the State Department of Education, and offer comprehensive special education services to students facing complex challenges due to emotional disturbance and developmental disabilities.

Meet "Sam", a graduate of our <u>San Diego Dual Diagnosis NPS</u>. Before joining Fred Finch, Sam struggled with anger and frustration due to bullying and challenges at previous schools. At Fred Finch, Sam learned to manage negativity, develop coping skills, and build practical life skills. Over time, Sam transformed into a confident individual, thanks to the supportive environment and dedicated staff.







Meet "Jane", a graduate of our <u>Avalon NPS in Oakland</u>. Jane faced significant challenges due to a learning disability and lack of early childhood education. When she first came to Fred Finch, she could not read or write and didn't want to be in a classroom. However, Fred Finch created a safe and supportive learning environment that helped her thrive. With the dedication of our staff and the right resources, Jane not only learned to read and write but also developed a love for learning, ultimately graduating with pride and confidence.

We remain dedicated to creating and partnering with schools where mental health, physical resilience, and wellness are prioritized, and where students can excel academically and thrive personally.
